

## Family Activity - Visit your Neighbors for Haiti

To get ready for the project, make copies of the list below. Plan a couple family walks in the next week or two. As you walk, visit the ten or twelve houses closest to your home. Get to know the people in the home, and explain to them that your family is doing a mission/service project together to support House of Hope, an orphanage for girls in Haiti. Give people the list of items you will be collecting, and tell them you will return later (try to give them a specific day). Explain that your church will be sending these items to Haiti to support the ministry and care for the girls. On the second walk you may want to take a wagon with you. Visit the homes again and collect items that they have purchased. Be sure to include a few items yourself, and then bring them to Genesis. We will make sure they end up on the ship headed to Haiti later this Fall.
