1 Corinthians 12:12-27

A spiritual gift is an ability that is empowered by the Holy Spirit and is used in the ministry of the church.

Wayne Grudem, Systematic Theology

Paul turns to his favorite image of the church as the Body of Christ

Ephesians 1:22-23

[22] And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, [23] which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all. (ESV)

Ephesians 4:11-16

[11] And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, [12] to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, [13] until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, [14] so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. [15] Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, [16] from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love. (ESV)

Three realities found in the church as the Body of Christ

I. The Body of Christ is Unique

Luke 3:16

[16] John answered them all, saying, "I baptize you with water, but he who is mightier than I is coming, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. (ESV)

- Unique in its diversity

II. The Body of Christ is Interdependent

Dangerous mindsets

3. I need something different
4. I don't need you

III. The Body of Christ is Vital
