Gifted, Part 2 – Are These Gifts For Today?

1 Corinthians 12:1-11

Two Teams

1. The God **has** spoken team
2. The God **is** speaking team

John 4:23

[23] But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. (ESV)

A spiritual gift is an ability that is empowered by the Holy Spirit and is used in the ministry of the church.

Wayne Grudem, Systematic Theology

The Gifts in This Passage

- Word of Wisdom - Unique ability to speak forth the wisdom of God, especially in an important situation
- Word of knowledge - Unique ability to speak for the knowledge of God and His purpose for the church
- Faith - Unique ability to trust God in the face of the impossible.
- Gifts of healings - God's healing powers displayed through prayer
- Working of miracles - Literally "acts of power", refers to mighty supernatural works like signs and wonders
- Prophecy - the telling forth of God's message in a particular situation, always in accordance to His Word and His work
- Distinguishing Spirits - The spiritual ability to discern between true doctrine and false, between the work of the Spirit and of demons
- Tongues - Speaking of a language that is not known by the speaker. Can refer to another human language or the language of angels, and can have a public and private prayerful application
- Interpretation of Tongues – Spirit-enabled ability to explain what is being said by a person speaking in tongues in the context of the public gathering

Three Views

Cessationism - The so called "miraculous" or "sign" gifts were given for the era of the Apostles

and ceased to exist as Spiritual Gifts either upon their deaths or the canonization of the New Testament.

Continuationism - The gifts are still available for the church today and have been experienced authentically in all of church history. Therefore, the church should be open to people pursuing and exercising every gift as a manifestation of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecostalism - The gifts are not only available but are essential and central in the church, and that certain gifts are the sign that people have been filled with the Holy Spirit.

HOW CAN WE AS A CHURCH DESIRE GREATER GIFTS

1. Prayer and fasting

Luke 11:13

[13] If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (ESV)

2. Come with prayerful expectation longing for the work of the Spirit

3. See Community Groups as a place for people to explore and test gifts

4. Get your heart engaged in worship
