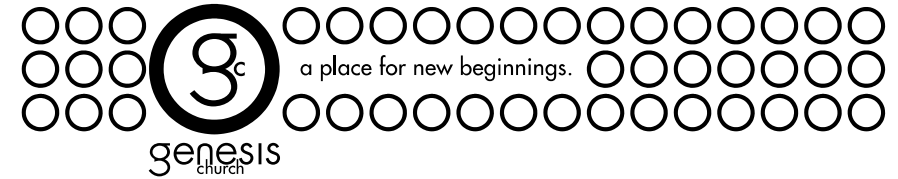

Sermon: *Audience of One*

Series: *Our Favorite Things*

Philippians 3:17-21 (p. 1085)



June 6, 2021

As we enter the Summer months, we are beginning a new and, hopefully, fun sermon series entitled *Our Favorite Things*.

We will have the opportunity to hear first sermons from the four preachers who recently completed our Preaching Cohort. Each has chosen a favorite passage for their sermon. Elders and staff were also asked to share their favorite Bible passages and the goal is to preach sermons from each of these favorite texts.

Today the series begins with Philippians 3:17-21, the favorite passage of Genesis Teaching Pastor, Mike Hubbard.

Paul was a scholar working his way to the top of the religious world. He had much to brag about as he built a reputation before his peers. Then he met Christ and everything changed. The things that once brought meaning, he now sees as worthless rubbish because it was replaced with something, or specifically someone, who was much better. His whole goal is to know Christ and live his life before the face of God. This too is our goal—to live our entire lives for an audience of one.
