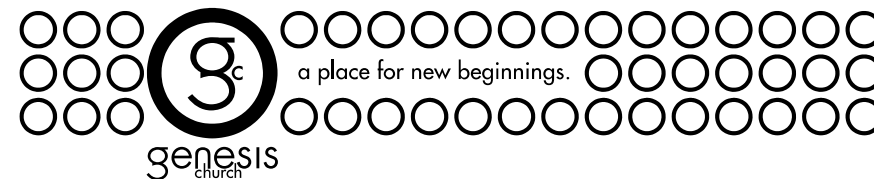

David Meyer is bringing the message today on the question,
“How can we talk to people about Jesus when they have no
faith background yet struggle with objections?” We are honored
to have David and Brenda with us today from Ecuador!

This week, we will be looking at the way the Apostle Paul
approached this question with the people of the city of
Thessalonica. The people of Thessalonica weren’t that different
in their thinking than those of our modern society. The
Thessalonians thought of religion mostly in terms of what the
myriad of gods could do for their own prosperity. The teaching
of the Gospel, a free gift of salvation through the sacrificial
death of a Man named Jesus on a Roman cross, was a difficult
concept for the Thessalonians to digest.

Paul gives us three principles in this chapter that we can use in
sharing our faith today. First, our preaching must be with the
boldness that comes from the conviction that we speak the
truth. Second, sharing our faith is just as much about sharing
our life of faith than it is about opening our mouth. And finally,
the effectiveness of our message rests in the God who provides
salvation, not on our own powers of persuasion.
