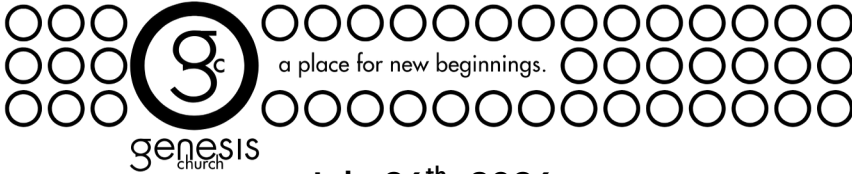

When we talk about David, our minds almost always jump to the story of David and Goliath. The unassuming shepherd boy who God used to defeat the Philistines. This shepherd would eventually become King, the best human King that Israel had in fact. But today, we see the other side of David in the Psalms. We'll see how David suffered unrighteously and felt God had abandoned him; we'll also see however when David cried out in repentance, God was faithful to restore David.

David was human and needed forgiveness for his sins; however, the beautiful truth is that Psalm 22 is not just about David – it is prefiguring Jesus on the cross, who on our behalf, endures the wrath of God for our sins. Yet, just as the Psalm says, God did not abandon Him; three days later, Jesus rose from the dead as proof that His sacrifice was true and good, and that the Father found what He had done and was well pleased.

Jesus didn't need the forgiveness found in Psalm 51 – but He is the one who offers it to any who will cry out to Him. The Serpent would have us believe that Jesus was only a good teacher, or a capable Prophet, but not the Messiah who was predicted and spoken of by David; Jesus crushes the Serpent by proving definitively that He is the Messiah, the long-awaited Son of Man who gave His life for His people.
